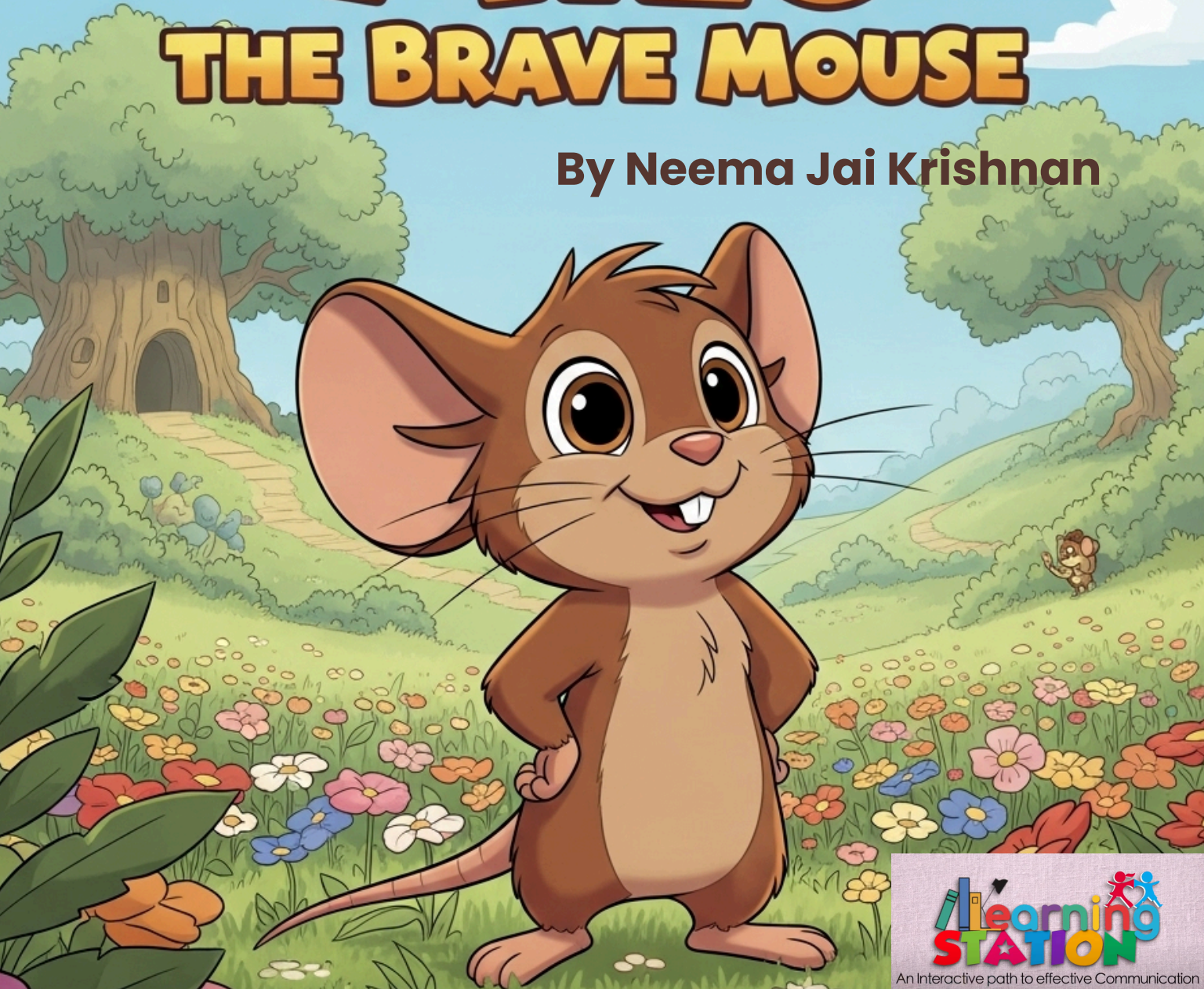


MiLO

- "What would you do if you were Milo?"

3. Story Retell:

After finishing, ask your child to tell the story back in their own words or mother tongue:

- "Can you tell me what happened to Milo?"
- "Who helped Milo find his way?"
